The same reaction took place when Andrew discovered Jesus for the first time as the Messiah.

Imagine living as a disciple of John the Baptist, hearing over and over that the promised Saviour of the world was about to come so people needed to be ready. Then one day He shows up and walks right by you! This fulfilled expectation made Andrew hurry to tell someone who would also enjoy the news, his brother Peter. The first step in sharing Jesus is to discover what He has done for you personally. Andrew saw Him and knew that He was the Messiah (or the Christ), the promised Saviour of the world.

What has Jesus done for you personally?

He willingly laid down His life to be the sin offering for humanity so that we can now know God personally forever (2 Corinthians 5:21, Romans 6:23). He took the complete judgement for our sins on the cross so that whoever believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life (John 3:16). Many people don't know this news so it is worth sharing.

FAITH IN ACTION: Heavenly Father, show me personally the good news of Jesus' finished work on the cross. Help me to share this good news with people around me in my everyday life. Thank you, Jesus. The gospel of Jesus Christ is the best news.
